What a busy but blessed time in ministry this last month.

We have officially started a new ministry in our church. We are now hosting classes from West Coast Baptist College to provide quality, Bible education to servant leaders here in El Salvador. On May 15, Dr. John Goetsch arrived and taught the first two classes in an intensive week format. Brother Mike Lester came down for two weeks to teach four more classes. The notes are being translated into Spanish by the team there in Lancaster, and I am doing my best to translate

for the actual class time. It has been a real blessing to our folks and other like-minded churches in the country as well.

We gifted all of our mothers a potted flower for Mother's Day and were able to see several people start to come through that special day.

Praise the Lord, the church celebrated it's 3rd anniversary (we have been here 10 months), and we saw a record attendance of 144. Although we were not making a big push for visitors, but for returning folks

on that day, we still had more than 20 visitors!

We have been blessed with an average attendance of 91 on Sunday mornings during May with 71 visitors. We have a lot of follow up to do, but we are thrilled with what the Lord is doing in this church. There were five saved this month, three in the services and two out soulwinning.

We are using our Dodge Caravan like a bus to bring in kids and whole families, but we are quickly running out of room. I have many times had 12-17 passengers in the seven seat van. We are praying that the Lord would provide us with a Micro bus (15 passenger van) to use in the church and school. A used one in decent condition costs about \$15,000. Please pray with us for this need.
