Dear Pastor and Church Family,

We praise the Lord for what He has done here these past two months. We have been working at strengthening the church here before we go, and also I have been studying the areas in and around Xochimilco, a district in Mexico City, where I believe God is guiding me to start a new work.

As the areas I'm looking at are getting more specific, I've started to look at housing and rent. Prices vary widely. There is a delegation inside Xochimilco called San Mateo, where I have found apartments in construction I'm interested in renting. Lord willing, when construction is finished, we can move over and start work!

One of the projects I was able to complete was the launching of a website for the new church. Iglesia Bautista Palabra de Dios, or Word of God Baptist Church, has a new home on the World Wide Web at www.digamexico.com. It is in Spanish, for the Mexican people here. Right now I am uploading videos of services here in Tizayuca.

God is stretching the faith of the church here in Tizayuca with some new financial needs. We are thankful for these needs, because we know that God is going to use them in the life of the church to show His power. First, please pray for the costs involved in getting the title of our land. The entire church is working to raise this money. When land is sold in Mexico much of the time, the title is not transferred until later, and the official doing the transaction can demand money. This person has asked for 5,000 pesos per lot, and we have three lots. It must be paid in six months or the land will return to the possession of the person who holds the title. I'm excited to see people laboring and sacrificing for their church. I look forward to seeing how God will meet this need and bless them for their sacrifice and love.

As we know that God has been moving us on to the next work, the Devil has been fighting spiritually. I have needed to cut back some of my trips to Mexico City to help with these battles, strengthening the church. Please pray for unity and the spirit of the First Baptist Church to remain as it is, and for God to use these people greatly for His kingdom. They have a heart to serve, to win souls, willingly disciple others, and are learning to give. All of these are precious, and I pray that this spirit is preserved. God has also added several new families to the church during this time, who are full of joy and fire to learn and grow. I thank God for them!
